



Richard Winter is Professor of Practical Theology and Director of the counselling programme at Covenant Theological Seminary in St Louis, MO, USA.

Richard is British and originally trained in Medicine at Bart's Hospital, London and then Psychiatry in Bristol. He was also a counsellor, teacher and

leader at the English L'Abri and associate pastor of a church in Hampshire for some years before moving to the United States. He is currently working on a new book on depression.
