Have you ever seen what God is doing across the world, through another country's eyes?

Japan has a population of more than 122 million people, and yet less than 1% of them are Christians, making it one of the **least reached** nations in the world.

Global Vision 2026 gives you an opportunity to get up close to Gospel ministry in Japan, meeting people on the front line, and praying together for God's work in locations where His grace and power are needed.

The trip will involve 10 days in **Tokyo & Hokkaido**, the two main regions where OMF Japan works, and getting oriented to cross-cultural ministry in this particular context.

Activities

- Visit **cultural sights** to gain insight into the religious and social setting
 - Visit a ministry to those affected by **homelessness**, offering practical help and connecting with guests
 - **Prayer** walks to seek God's blessing for the city, its people and its ministry workers
 - Help with an **evangelistic** event for those who have returned to Japan from other countries
 - Attend Japanese **church** Sunday meetings
 - Learn from OMF **missionaries** about the nature of work in Japan
 - Visit OMF Japan's language & orientation **school**

Budget

The cost of the trip will be around **£2,000**, which includes:

- Flights between London and Japan
- Accommodation, food, and travel in Japan, including flights between Tokyo and Hokkaido
- Orientation and OMF administration

Not included are costs related to visas, vaccinations, travel to orientation and London airport, extra snacks and sundries.

Bursaries are available, and we aim to ensure that financial constraints do not prevent participation.
